

How to Sort and Dispose of Waste

Important Guide

Please leave waste at the designated collection point in your district by 8:00 AM on the collection day.

Burnable Waste

Plastic items

Collection Days: Monday, Wednesday, Friday

Use the designated blue garbage bags. Do not put out waste at night or after 8:00 AM.

Large-Sized Waste / Metal Waste / Household Batteries



Large-Sized Waste

Please dispose of Large-Sized Waste separately



Examples: Bicycles, furniture, or items under 1m in width, height, and depth, weighing up to 10kg.

Metal Waste



Items larger than 3-liter cans should be placed in designated garbage bags or tied with wire

Collection Once a month, on Tuesdays. Schedule: Check your district's schedule

☆1st Tuesday: Okawa, Hokkawa, Naramomoto (大川、北川、奈良本) ☆2nd Tuesday: Atagawa, Katase, Yugaoka, Shiradahama, Karasawa (熱川、片瀬、湯ヶ岡、白田浜、唐沢)

☆3rd Tuesday: Iriya, Mizushita, Tamachi (except Karasawa), Nishicho (including Dontsuku-dori), Higashicho(入谷、水下、田町(唐沢除く)、西町(どんつく通り含む)、東町)

☆4th Tuesday: Tamachi, Nishicho, Higashicho Main Streets, Inatori along Route 135 (田町・西町・東町の大通り、稲取地区の国道 135 線沿い)

☆No collection on 5th Tuesdays.

Check your district and dispose of waste using the designated method by 8:00 AM on the specified day. Do not put out waste at night or after 8:00 AM.

Household Batteries

Glass Bottles

Clear bottles, Brown bottles, Other color bottles

Remove caps, rinse bottles, and sort them by color. Use the designated red garbage bags.









Fluorescent Lamps

Please dispose of fluorescent lamps separately.

Collection Day: Tuesday


Please sort bottles by color and dispose of them in the designated garbage bag. The categories are as follows:

☆Clear bottles ☆Brown bottles ☆Other color bottles


Use the designated red garbage bag for recyclable and non-burnable waste. Place the garbage at the collection point by 8:00 AM on the collection day. Do not put out garbage at night or after 8:00 AM.

Recyclable Waste

Paper cartons, newspapers, magazines, direct mail, flyers (bundle with paper string) Cardboard (bundle with string; max size: 1m x 1m, up to 10 pieces)











PET bottles

Remove caps and labels from PET bottles, and dispose of them as burnable waste.







the designated garbage bag

There are designated collection boxes for clothing, used cooking oil, and ink cartridges.

Collection Day: Wednesday (Canceled on rainy days)

Remove caps and labels from PET bottles, and dispose of them as burnable waste.

Non-Collectible Items

 \bigstar If a "Cannot Be Collected" notice is attached to your waste, please take it back with you. ☆ Items such as home appliances (recycling-targeted), construction waste, industrial waste, and hazardous materials cannot be collected or dropped off at the facility.

☆ For large amounts of waste (e.g., from moving or cleaning), please take it directly to the Eco Clean Center Touga.

Use the designated red garbage bag for recyclable and non-burnable waste. Place the garbage at the collection point by 8:00 AM on the collection day. Do not put out garbage at night or after 8:00 AM.

🖈 Battery Collection Boxes: Located at public halls in the Joto district and at MaxValu Inatori store.

 \bigstar Clothing Collection Boxes: Located on the first floor of the Higashiizu-cho Hall (fisheries cooperative side entrance).

Cans



Empty the contents of the cans and rinse them clean. Only cans up to 3 liters are allowed. For spray cans, use up all the contents before disposal. Do not make holes in the cans.



Collection Day:

Use the designated red garbage bag for recyclable and non-burnable waste. Place the garbage at the collection point by 8:00 AM on the collection day. Do not put out garbage at night or after 8:00 AM.

Non-Collectible Waste Important Notes * Futons: Please take futons directly to the disposal facility.

**Cannot Be Collected or Accepted at the Facility: TVs, washing machines, air conditioners, refrigerators, clothes dryers, computers, etc.

Other Important Rules

- 1.Bring recyclable items and empty bottles to recycling collections whenever possible.
- 2.Empty pesticide, chemical, or toxic substance bottles must be returned to the retailer.
- 3.The Eco Clean Center does not accept waste on Saturdays.
- 4.On Sundays, you can bring waste directly to the Eco Clean Center (8:15 AM 4:30 PM).
